

6 Month Old Developmental Milestones

Intellectual	• Begins to pass things from one hand to the other • Shows curiosity about things and tries to get things that are out of reach • Looks around at nearby objects
Social	• Responds to sounds by making sounds • Brings vowels together when babbling, such as “ah”, “eh”, “oh” • Responds to own name • May make sounds to show joy or displeasure
Emotional	• Knows familiar faces and knows if someone is a stranger • Enjoys playing with others, especially parents and caregivers • Likes to look in a mirror • Responds to others’ emotions
Physical	• Rolls over in both directions (back to front; front to back) • Begins to sit without support • Rocks back and forth on all fours; may crawl backwards • When standing, supports weight on legs and might bounce
Physical	• May begin to crawl • Stands while holding onto an object like the sofa or a push toy • Can get self into a sitting position • May pull to stand
